ENTRY FEE \$10

FORMAT

1. Each player competes only with the players within your foursome.
2. Each hole is given a skin value of \$2.
3. The player with the single best NET score wins the hole and is given his skin money at the end of the hole.
4. If the hole is tied, the skin (\$2) is carried over to the next hole.
5. Net score is used to determine the winner of the hole.
6. January handicaps will be used for each player.
7. A team captain will be assigned for each team to hand out skin money.
8. An envelope with \$36 will be given to each captain at check-in.
9. Each player shall "play out" every hole and post their score, but not as a T-score

TOURNAMENT PROCEDURE:

1. Check in at the tournament desk for your score cards and your envelope 30 minutes before your scheduled starting time.
2. All score cards must be dated, signed and attested.
3. Players can sign up individually or form their own foursome.

ELIGIBILITY and SIGN-UP:

You must be a member of the men's 18 hole golf club and have a current SCGA handicap and pay the entry fee. Sign up at the January Men's Club Meeting.

**Tournament Format**

1. Play two (2) rounds of golf and use the same score card for both rounds.
2. Record only GROSS scores on March 11<sup>th</sup> and the 18<sup>th</sup>.
3. Record your best Net score on each hole for your ECLECTIC score.
4. February Handicaps will be used for this Tournament.
5. There will be four (4) flights in this Tournament for payouts
6. FLIGHTS PLAYING EARLY THE FIRST WEEK WILL PLAY LATER THE SECOND WEEK.
7. Advise the Tournament Chairman if you have a problem with the schedule.

**Tournament Procedures**

1. Check in 20 minutes before your scheduled starting time.
2. All scorecards must be filled out accurately, signed, attested and placed in the scorecard box to be at the check-in table.
3. Scores for both days must be posted.
4. The gross scores for March 11<sup>th</sup> will be posted as "T" scores.
5. The gross scores for March 18<sup>th</sup> will be posted but not as "T" scores
6. Remember to post adjusted gross scores if necessary.
7. We recommend that cards be exchanged within your group.

**Eligibility and Sign-up**

You must be a member of the Laguna Woods Men's 18 Hole Golf Club and have a current S.C.G.A. handicap and the tournament entry fee. Sign up for the tournament at the Men's Club monthly meeting on February 24<sup>th</sup> 2009.

FORMAT

10. This is an individual tournament and not a team event.
11. The Stableford System is a scoring system where points are earned based on your Net Score.
12. May Handicaps will be used.
13. Points are awarded as follows:
  - a. Net Eagle = 7 Points
  - b. Net Birdie = 5 points
  - c. Net Par = 3 Points
  - d. Net Bogeys = 1 Point.
14. Each player shall “play out” every hole and post their score, but not as a T-score.

TOURNAMENT PROCEDURE:

4. Check in at the tournament desk for you score cards 30 minutes before your scheduled starting time.
5. All score cards must be dated, signed and attested.

ELIGIBILITY and SIGN-UP:

You must be a member of the men's 18 hole golf club and have a current SCGA handicap and pay the entry fee. Sign up at the April Men's Club Meeting. Players can sign up individually or form their own foursome

## CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT

JULY 2010

### **FORMAT**

The Club Championship Tournament consists of three (3) rounds of Medal Play. Play starts on Wednesday, August 5<sup>th</sup>, continuing on August 12<sup>th</sup> and ending August 19<sup>th</sup>. All play will be on Courses 1 and 2. Handicaps will be based on each Golfers "July 2009 Index" as published in the July 2009 Handicap Report.

### **FLIGHTS**

Five (5) flights will be used for the Club Championship Tournament. **Each club members has the option of playing in the Championship Flight or the Flight designated for his July 2009 Index.** The flights are as follows;

#### **Championship Flight - Open**

**OPEN TO ALL MEMBERS.** All members with a July Index of 9.9 or lower will be assigned to the Championship Flight.

Golfers in this flight play from the blue tees and handicaps are not used.

#### **Flights A, B, C, (Indices from 10.0 to 23.9)**

Flight A = 10.0 to 14.2

Flight B = 14.3 to 19.2

Flight C = 19.3 to 23.9

Members play from White Tees and competitions score will be net scores.

#### **Flight D (Indices from 24.0 to 29.1) and Flight E (Indices from 29.1 to 36.4+)**

Flight D and Flight E members will play as one Flight. Members play from the Gold Tees and competitions score will be net scores.

### **TOURNAMENT PROCEDURE:**

On the first day of play, foursomes will be assigned such that members with similar handicaps play in the same group. On the second and third round, foursomes will be assigned based on the outcome of previous play.

Starting times will be set by the Tournament Director. Requests for early, mid-day or late play will be accommodated where possible. Please make request only on a mandatory basis. That is, if you cannot get your requested time, you cannot play in the tournament.

Check in at the tournament desk for your score cards 30 minutes before your scheduled starting time. All score cards must be dated, signed and attested.

Detailed "Rules of Play" will be posted prior to the Tournament.

ELIGIBILITY and SIGN-UP:

You must be a member of the men's 18 hole golf club and have a current SCGA handicap and pay the entry fee. In addition, a member must play in at least two "Major" or 4 Wednesday tournaments during the calendar year to be eligible to play. All past Club Champions shall be exempt from the requirement to qualify for the Club Championship Tournament under this section.

New members without an established "July Index" will be assigned a July Index by the Handicap Chairman. **Sign up at the July Men's Club Meeting.** Players must sign up individually, the Tournament Chairman will form play groupings.

STANDBY AND CANCELLATION LISTS

Cancellation and standby lists will be available at the Major Tournament Bulletin Board. Final cut-off for sign-ups will be Monday at 6:00 P.M., August 3rd, 2009. After this time call the Tournament Director (Dan Davis) for availability of tournament space.

The Tournament is closed at the end of the first day for new entries.

## MAJOR TOURNAMENT

### TEAM SKINS - AUGUST

#### MAJOR TOURNAMENT

ENTRY FEE \$10

#### **TOURNAMENT FORMAT:**

Team Skins is a four man scramble. Sign up individually and partners will be assigned based on handicaps. The entry field will be divided into four Flights (A,B,C,D) from low to high handicaps. Teams (foursomes) will be comprised of one player from each Flight.

The Flight A player will be designated as "Captain" and will make all decisions for the Team during play. Two score cards are to be kept during the round of play and turned in to the Tournament Scoring Committee. Both cards must be signed by all team members. The Captain and all team members are responsible to ensure that both score cards record the same information. Discrepancies may lead to disqualification of part or all of the team's results. For payout purposed the teams will be divided into two Groups. The highest handicap Captains will form one group and the lower handicap Captains the other Group.

#### **TOURNAMENT PROCEDURE:**

All team members hit a tee shot and the Captain selects a ball to continue play. Once the ball is selected, each player will hit a ball from that position and the Captain selects the best ball. This procedure is followed until the ball is holed out.

#### **RULES:**

1. The Team shall record which player hit the "Drive" selected by the Captain.
  2. The Flight A and B player must each hit four (4) drives during the round of play.
  3. The Flight C and D players must hit a combined total of four (4) drives.
  4. The Ball in play may be moved one club length in the fairway or rough but no closer to the green. A ball may not be moved in bounds, out of a sand trap, or onto the putting green by the "one club" rule.
  5. The Ball can be move up to six inches on the green but no closer to the hole.
  6. UNEVEN TEAMS -----
    1. Captain Absent ----- #2 Player plays two shots
    2. #2 Player Absent --- #1 and #3 Player play alternate shots
    3. #3 Player Absent --- #2 and #4 Player play alternate shots.
    4. #4 Player Absent ---- #3 Player plays two shots
2. Each Player on an uneven team must have a minimum of four (4) drives

#### **PRIZES**

Prizes will be determined by the Major Tournament Chairman depending on the number of teams.

#### **ELIGIBILITY:**

You must be a member of the men's 18 hole golf club and have a current SCGA handicap and pay the entry fee. Sign up at the June Men's Club Meeting.

#### **STANDBY AND CANCELLATION LISTS:**

Cancellation and standby lists will be available at the Major Tournament Bulletin Board outside the Pro Shop. Final cut-off for sign-ups will be Monday at 5:00 P.M., July 6, 2009. After this time call for availability of tournament space.

## **BEST SCORE NASSAU**

**SEPTEMBER**  
ENTRY FEE = \$10

### **FORMAT**

The "Best Score Nassau" Tournament is designed to increase the number of payouts. Awards are based on low score for the first nine holes of play, the second nine holes, and for the entire round of eighteen.

The Best Score Nassau is an individual event.

### **PROCEDURE**

Members with September Indices 23.9 and below will play from the white tees. Members with indices 24.0 and above will play from the Gold Tees.

Rules of Golf apply. No "bumping" or otherwise interfering with the ball in play. All putts will be holed out (do not "give putts").

### **AWARDS**

**Net scores** will be used for determining awards. September 2010 handicaps will be used. Prizes will be awarded by flight.

Winners will be determined and prizes awarded for **low net scores** as follows:

Overall 18 Holes - Front 9 Holes - Back 9 Holes

**A member cannot win more than one segment.**

### **TOURNAMENT PROCEDURE:**

Check in at the tournament desk for your score cards 20 minutes before your scheduled starting time. All score cards must be dated, signed and attested.

**Players may select playing partners or the Tournament Chairman will assign foursomes**

### **ELIGIBILITY and SIGN-UP:**

You must be a member of the men's 18 hole golf club and have a current SCGA handicap and pay the entry fee. Sign up at the August Club Meeting.

### **STANDBY AND CANCELLATION LISTS:**

Cancellation and standby lists will be available at the Major Tournament Bulletin Board outside the Pro Shop. Final cut-off for sign-ups will be Monday at 5:00 P.M., September 7, 2009. After this time call for availability of tournament space.

**FORMAT:**

1. FOUR PLAYER (FOURSOME) SCRAMBLE.
2. **SIGN UP INDIVIDUALLY.**
3. TEAMS WILL BE FORMED FROM A,B,C,&D. FLIGHT GOLFERS
4. REGULAR SCRAMBLE FORMAT. EACH PLAYER HITS A SHOT. PICK THE BEST BALL FROM THE FOUR SHOTS AND EACH PLAYER HITS AGAIN FROM THAT SPOT. CONTINUE UNTIL THE BALL IS IN THE HOLE AND GO TO THE NEXT HOLE.
5. MORE RULES TO BE PROVIDED TOURNAMENT DAY.

**SCORING:**

HANDICAPS ARE NOT USED FOR THIS TOURNAMENT. HOWEVER, FOURSOME WILL BE BALANCED BY TOTAL HANDICAP.

**ELIGIBILITY AND SIGN-UP:**

YOU MUST BE A MEMBER OF THE MEN'S 18 HOLE GOLF CLUB, HAVE A S.C.G.A. HANDICAP AND PAY THE ENTRY FEE.

SIGN-UP AT THE SEPTEMBER MEN'S CLUB MEETING OR AT THE CLUB HOUSE ON THE STANDBY SHEET.

#### FORMAT:

This is a four (4) player Team Event. Sign up individually and we will assign you Partners, one from each of the four (4) groups (A, B, C &D)

November handicaps will be used for each player to make up Teams as equal as possible in total handicap. All Team members must play each hole completely as individual scores are to be posted. **POST YOUR SCORE, BUT NOT AS A "T" SCORE.**

All Teams must have at least three players. Three player Teams record the best net scores for par 5 and par 4 holes as below. On par 3 holes the two best net scores and a maximum of 5 shots for the third score will be used.

#### TEAM SCORING:

- (1) On par five holes the best one (1) net score is the team score for that hole.
- (2) On par four holes the two (2) best net scores are added as the team score.
- (3) On par three holes the three (3) best net scores are added as the team score

#### ELIGIBILITY:

You must be a member of the men's 18 hole golf club, have a SCGA index and pay the tournament entry fee.

#### STANDBY AND CANCELLATION LISTS:

Cancellation and standby lists will be available at the Major Tournament Bulletin Board outside the Pro Shop. Final cut-off for sign-ups and team assignments will be made and posted by Sunday at 6:00 P.M., November 8th, 2009. After this time the standby list will be used for replacement players only.
